

**LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A  
PREMISES LICENCE**

**TAKE NOTICE** that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

**FUNKY BOX, 122-126 BRIDGE STREET  
WARRINGTON WA1 2RU**

The grounds for review are:

That the licensing objectives of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety have not been promoted at the premises in that there have been breaches in the mandatory conditions on the licence with regard to the promotion of irresponsible drinking, failure to provide free tap water on request, and failure to dispense alcohol in approved measures. There has also been a breach of the CCTV condition in Annexe 2 of the Licence in the respect that there was a failure to make available CCTV records on request by a Police or Authorised Officer. In addition, conditions in Annexe 3 have been breached in the respect that there has been a failure to ensure that a Personal Licence holder is on the premises to supervise alcohol sales at all times, an incomplete Refusals Log and incomplete Incident Log. Finally, the correct Premises Licence Summary was not displayed on the premises.

The register containing a record of the grounds for review can be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at:

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the 11<sup>th</sup> November 2011.

*It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.*
