TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

The grounds for review are:

The inordinate number of incidents of violence and theft within the premises. That the Licensing Objective of Prevention of Crime and Disorder has not been promoted at the premises.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the 28 day of August 2009.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
