



LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

Warrington

The grounds for review are:

That the nature and style of the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives, particularly:

- Prevention of Crime & Disorder – The number of incidents of drunkenness, violence, anti-social behaviour and drug abuse at the premises.
- Breaches of current licence conditions imposed on the Premises Licence.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the **2nd November 2017**.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
