COVID-19 RESPONSE – LONDON ROAD, STOCKTON HEATH – SUSPENSION OF LIMITED WAITING BAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, with effect from Monday 22nd June 2020, for a period not exceeding 21 days, the Council will introduce the following restriction: -

1. Temporarily suspend the Order specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

The restriction will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Notice supersedes any contravening orders. The restriction is required to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures.
