**THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (LONDON ROAD, STOCKTON HEATH)**  
**(SUSPENSION OF LIMITED WAITING BAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce the following restriction: -

1. Temporarily suspend the Order specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

The order will be effective from 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020 for a maximum period of 18 months and will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Order supersedes any contravening orders. The restriction is required to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures.
