COVID-19 RESPONSE–SCOTLAND ROAD-20 MPH SPEED LIMIT & SUSPENSION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, with effect from Thursday 11th June 2020, for a period not exceeding 21 days, the Council will introduce the following restrictions: -

1. Temporarily suspend the Notice/Order specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. Introduce a 20 mph speed limit restriction on Scotland Road from a point 41 metres south east of its junction with Winwick Street to its junction with Bus Station mini roundabout.

The restrictions will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Notice supersedes any contravening orders. The restrictions are required to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures.
