

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (SCOTLAND ROAD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT & SUSPENSION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) is satisfied that the said roads should be restricted to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures that will affect the highway:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:


1. The Notice/Order specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order are temporarily suspended to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on Scotland Road from a point 41 metres south east of its junction with Winwick Street to its junction with Bus Station mini roundabout.
3. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months from the date of operation and supersedes any contravening orders.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July 2020 and may be cited as “The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (Scotland Road) (20 MPH Speed Limit & Suspension of Hackney Carriage Stand) Temporary Order 2020”.

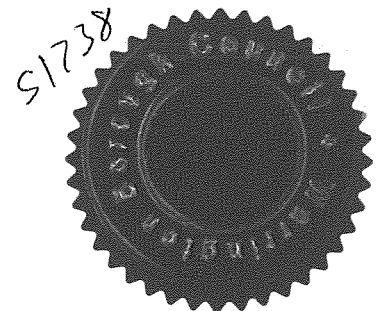
SCHEDULE – SUSPENSIONS

Local Government Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1976 – Revocation & Appointment of Hackney Carriages (Notice dated 8 th September 2011)	Stand located on Scotland Road – South west side from a point 31 metres south east of its junction with the projected line of the east side of Winwick Street for a distance of 38 metres in a south easterly direction – 24 Hours – 7 Spaces
The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2018	Is suspended in so far as it relates to the following: - <u>Schedule 96 – Hackney Carriage Stand Clearway:</u> Scotland Road – Stand on south western side between Winwick Street and Town Hill.
